Netanya is located on the Mediterranean Sea, and not only offers a great starting point for a tour across Israel and the Middle East, but also a great place to spend your time

Netanya is the sports' capital of Israel. It is home to the pro circuit stage of the World Surf League, the Stadium of the decorated football club Maccabi Netanya, the Israeli Beach Football League and to the Wingate Institute which will host the championships.



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Wingate Institute - Competition venue

The Wingate Institute is Located in an excellent location in central Israel, close to the coastal cliff, with walking trails overlooking the Mediterranean Sea, between green lawns and in a pastoral setting.

In addition, Wingate Institute has a multi-disciplinary Center for Sports Medicine and Research with an excellent international reputation.

The Wingate Institute is the perfect place for athletes and sport teams camps, combining optimal conditions and a unique athletic atmosphere. It hosts a basic sports hotel, offering a large variety of delicious breakfast, lunch and dinner with a menu adjusted and optimized for athletes

On top of pools there are a few enclosed and climate controlled sports halls, outdoor sports facilities of all kinds, a gym and recovery facilities

The swimming and water polo complex includes the National Pool and the Olympic pool.

The National Pool, which will host all matches, is a 55X25 m' one, and stands for over 900 spectators.

Training and warmup will take place at the next door open Olympic 20X50 m' pool.





















Competition during the pandemic

After causing the cancellation of the competition last year, unfortunately the Covid 19 is still very present in our lives this year as well, and will have its impact on the event organization.

It is extremely important that you read carefully all the instructions and follow the instructions.

A. Entry to Israel

In effort to stop new variant entry, the state of Israel has a severe protocol for entering the country during the pandemic, and requires all international athletes and delegates to be invited by the local Ministry of Sport and Culture. Only players, official teams' delegates and referees will be allowed in, and in order for that to happen, we ask for the followings from each participating country:

- 1. Fill and submit (to both our Covid-19 supervisor & arrivals coordinator contacts in page 4) the Excel sheet attached as Appendix 1 (Arrival form) in whole by September 21th at the latest.
- **2.** Prepare photocopies of all arrivals passports. A link to a shared folder will be sent to each participating country separately, and the copies should be uploaded to that folder
- **3.** Each head of delegation needs to sign the DELEGATION WAIVER form that is attached, and all arrivals need to sign the PERSONAL WAIVER. All signed waivers should also be uploaded to the shared folder until Oct. 1st
- 4. Health insurance policies proof, that include

- coverage of Covid -19 expenses, for all arrivals, needs to be presented. Such proof should also be uploaded to the link that will be provided separately to each national team.
- **5.** Referees, who are staying at a separate hotel, must be fully vaccinated, and their vaccination approval must be uploaded to the same shared folder as the rest of the documentation.
- **6.** 24 hour prior to landing in Israel, each would be requested to fill an individual online declaration, and state that he does not suffer from any symptoms or had been recently exposed to a sick person. Arrivals will also need to declare they are aware of the quarantine requirements that will be specified in the next clause. After filling the declaration each arrival will get a link to schedule a Covid test upon arrival in the airport and pre-pay for it. The test's cost is 80 NIS (about 22 Euros) if reserved and paid in advance through the link, or 100 NIS if paid upon arrival. Anyway arrivals cannot leave the airport without being tested. Results will be sent to the email address filled when booking the test, and to the Covid-19 production supervisor. Normally results are being sent up to 24 hours after the test, but we'll secure them by 10:00 AM the day after to all those how land by 20:00 on the 6th, or by 16:00 for those who land between 20:00

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B. Upon arrival

Each team will leave the Airport on its own shuttle bus, directly to one of the two bubble hotels reserved exclusively for the competition (more information on page 13) in which it booked rooms. The arrival protocol should be as follows:

- **1.** Upon arrival to the hotel, a team delegate will approach the reception counter and receive an envelope with all room keys and a rooming list according to the booking form that was sent in advance.
- **2.** The rest of the team will wait in the bus, where the keys will be handed to the all team members, and from there they'll go directly to their rooms.
- **3.** Until the results of the Airport tests will arrive, all team members should stay in their rooms. The hotel will be prepared to provide meals to the rooms.
- **4.** Once results will arrive, all those who received negative results will receive a hand rist which will allow them to move freely in the competition hotel.
- **5.** Referees, who arrive a day later, will be going through the same procedure, except the fact that instead of a bus they'll have a taxi, and upon arrival at the hotel there will be a desk outside where they'll receive their key and head to their room. Estimated cost per test is 370 NIS. Teams who need the test should address the Covid-19 supervisor by Sep 30th at the latest.

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C. During the event

Generally speaking, all those who arrive in Israel are required to stay 14 days in quarantine, especially those who are not fully vaccinated (if allowed in...). The event participants will be obviously excluded, under the following terms:

- 1. They all must stay at the competition hotel only, allowed to leave by private shuttle service only to the competition and training facilities and back.
- **2.** As previously mentioned, in order to avoid possible outburst in the hotel, until receiving a negative PCR test result, all arrivals should stay in their rooms.
- **3.** Teams will not be allowed to stay at the competition site after their training session or match.
- **4.** Disinfection of locker rooms and shuttle buses will take place after each team will leave, therefore the schedule will be carefully planned, and needs to be strictly followed. Each time slot (for both matches and training sessions) will be a bit longer to allow windows for the disinfection process, as you can learn in the following schedule.
- **5.** The Referees hotel is being shared with FINA officials and other guests, therefore it is essential that only fully vaccinated referees will be appointed. A separate dining area will be spared for the competition participants, and also separate floors. A specific public area will

be designated at the officials' hotel for the competition participants.

- **6.** Masks should be used at all times while on public areas in doors, except for the obvious while in training, during matches or while dining.
- **7.** Social distancing should be kept as much as possible
- 8. Prior to departure PCR tests The LOC will coordinate PCR tests at the teams' hotels for those who need them, on Friday, Oct 15. Estimated cost per test is 370 NIS. Teams who need the test should address the Covid-19 supervisor by Sep 30th at the latest. All LOC members, hotel workers, bus drivers, pool workers and others who may come in contact with the competition participants will be fully vaccinated. The teams' local volunteers will be tested prior to meeting the teams and will be joining the competition bubble, including sleeping for the whole time in the bubbles hotels with the teams. The LOC will do its absolute best to make the time at the hotels as pleasant as possible, and that you'll all have a safe and enjoyable stay.

As was mentioned in the previous section, 3 Hotels were secured for the competition - Two of them are closed for the competition participants only and will serve the teams (taking into consideration not all of the players and team members are fully vaccinated they must be kept

totally separated from the general public), and the referees hotel will be shared with both FINA officials and other guest. We have picked 2 levels of hotels, to try and allow everyone to find the best solution for their needs and budget. The amount of rooms in each hotel is limited, so in order for you to have a choice - we urge you to complete registration fast Here are the hotel rates:

How to book your rooms?

Appendix 2 (which will be sent to you by Monday, Sep 6th), is a form, created by Amsalem tours to allow you to place your booking. Please keep in mind that due to the Covid-19 situation local authorities strongly advises against triple rooms, which can also cause problems in case a positive player will be detected, therefore we booked 12 rooms per team, but can show some flexibility - more rooms can be provided if necessary and 11 or 10 can also be acceptable.

The procedure will be as follows –

- 1. Receive the booking form and fill in major details Delegate contact details, Hotel choice, and number of single & double rooms. Names and rooming lit can be completed later.
- 2. Send the form to both Tidhar & Gini from the LOC (details in the Meet the LOC page). The forms will be addressed according to their arrival order.
- 3. Once your booking was confirmed by either Gini or Tidhar you'll get a message that asks you to complete your booking by paying a down payment which is 40% of your total booking. The transfer details will be on the registration form. Transfer proof should be sent right after it was done.
- 4. A reservation not backed up by a down payment proof will be canceled 48 hours after it was confirmed and the rooms could be reserved by another team.
- 5. Once one of the hotels will be full we'll publish a notice. In case we'll receive a booking to a full hotel before the announcement was published we'll replay privately to the relevant delegate.
- 6. Final payment of the rest of the 60% should be made no later than September 30th.

All Hotels are experienced with hosting sports delegation, will allow some adjustments to the meals menus and flexible hours to guarantee even after late games a warm meal will be served:














